At the monthly Council meeting held on the 18th July the Council considered the Part 8 report from the Chief Executive in relation to the proposal to renovate and extend the Mayfair for use as general office space and associated facilities.

In total 60 submissions were received during the public consultation process. These submissions were considered by the Council and having regard to the submissions made, the recommendation from the Chief Executive was to proceed with the proposal to renovate and extend the Mayfair subject to revised elevational treatments.

During the public consultation period the proposed development was referred to An Bord Pleanála by a third party to determine should an Environmental Impact Statement and Natura Impact Statement be prepared for the proposed development.

An Bord Pleanála determined that neither should be prepared having regard, amongst other considerations, to:

- The nature and scale of the proposed development
- The location of the proposed development
- The construction management approach
- The layout of the site

The revisions to the proposed design were accepted and approved by the Council members.
