Report to Council on the Graveyard Grant Scheme 2017

25 applications have been received for the Graveyard Grants Scheme 2017. Overall funding sought amounts to over €65,000 and the budget allocation is €10,000. There is a separate budget allocation of €5,000 for burial ground improvements.

21 of the applications have already been approved for funding by Council. Two further applications are now being recommended for approval at the November 2017 Council Meeting (see summary overleaf).

The total amount of funding recommended to date is €12,670. It is proposed to allocate the balance from the €5,000 Burial Grounds Improvements budget.

Recommendation:

Approval is sought for a funding commitment of €700 for 2 Graveyards at the November Council Meeting.
