Site Location & Description

Springmount is a residential development of 22 houses located in the townland of Smithsland South on the southern edge of Kilkenny City. The development is accessed from a single entrance off the N10, Waterford Road. The dwellings are all detached with private gardens and are served by mains water and sewage. As well as roads and footpaths, the public area of the development also contains a green area of approximately 0.1 Ha.

<u>Planning History</u>

Planning permission was granted to Nolan Brothers for 22 houses under Planning Permission Reference P86/43. The permission is approximately 30 years old and it is understood that the development was substantially complete by the early 1990's.

TIC Request:

The formal taking-in-charge application was received from the residents of the estate on 10th July 2010. Subsequent to this, the Planning Authority engaged with the developer to progress the process. The developer did engage somewhat and undertook a number of the remedial works as identified by the various service areas. In addition the Planning Authority made a claim on the bond to carry out the necessary CCTV works and complete repairs. All works as identified by the various service areas and the Planning Officer in the public areas have now been completed.

Recommendation:

Having regard to the substantial completion of the development in accordance with the conditions attached to the grants of permission and the completion of all works as identified by the various internal service areas, I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the formal taking in charge of Springmount, Waterford Road, Kilkenny, as outlined on the attached map.
