A Chara,

The Community and Cultural/Inter-Cultural Facilities Capital Scheme is funded from development contributions and an annual budget of €250,000 is provided. The budget for 2021, therefore, is €250,000.

Applications for the 2021 CCFCS were advertised with a closing date for receipt of applications of Friday 16th April, 2021. The Council received a total of 22 applications and the overall amount being sought is € 725,145.

The applications were evaluated in a two stage evaluation process having regard to the following:

- The feasibility and realistic nature of the project and the matching funds being in place,
- The extent to which the capital project supports the objectives of the County Development Plan,
- The community collaboration and consultation involved and the extent to which the project supports broader community uses,
- The need for the project and the added value that the project will bring,



- The capacity of the community group to deliver the project,
- The demonstration of social inclusion and accessibility and
- The level of disadvantage and social circumstances in the area.

The number of applications received and the variety and nature of the projects illustrate significant local community commitment to community, rural and cultural development.

In the context of the available budget of €250,000 and having regard to the criteria of the Scheme and the evaluation undertaken, I recommend the following applications be grant aided under the Community and Culture/Inter-cultural Facilities Grant Scheme 2021.
