## DRAFT KILKENNY COUNTY COUNCIL BURIAL GROUND BYE-LAWS 2024

Kilkenny County Council proposes to make Burial Ground Bye-Laws in respect of the area comprising of Kilkenny City and County under Section 199 of the Local Government Act 2001(as amended) for the regulation of open burial grounds in the ownership of Kilkenny County Council.
