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**Site Location & Description**

Chapel View is a residential development consisting of 36 dwellings located within Stoneyford Village. The dwellings are a mixture of detached and semi-detached 2 storey buildings. The estate is accessed via a single access point onto the main street in Stoneyford (R713).

**Planning History**

- P02/812: Permission granted subject to 27 no. conditions to Robert Finnegan for the erection of 36 no. fully serviced dwelling houses and associated site works, on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2002.
- P04/1859: Permission granted subject to 5 no. conditions to GMB Construction Ltd. for a change of house type on 3 no. houses on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2005.

**TIC Request:**

The formal application to have this development taken in charge was made by the residents on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2010. The application was referred to the various internal service areas and based on the responses a schedule of necessary works was prepared. The developer entered into receivership in 2013 and the council subsequently engaged with the bond holder to secure funding to complete the necessary works. The bond was paid out in 2018 with works commencing at the end of 2018. All works necessary to bring the development to the standard for taking in charge have now been completed.

**Recommendation:**

Having regard to the completion of the development in substantial accordance with the conditions attached to the grant of permission and the completion of all works as identified by the various internal service areas, I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the formal taking in charge of Chapel View, Stoneyford, Co. Kilkenny, as outlined on the attached map.
