
TIC Request:

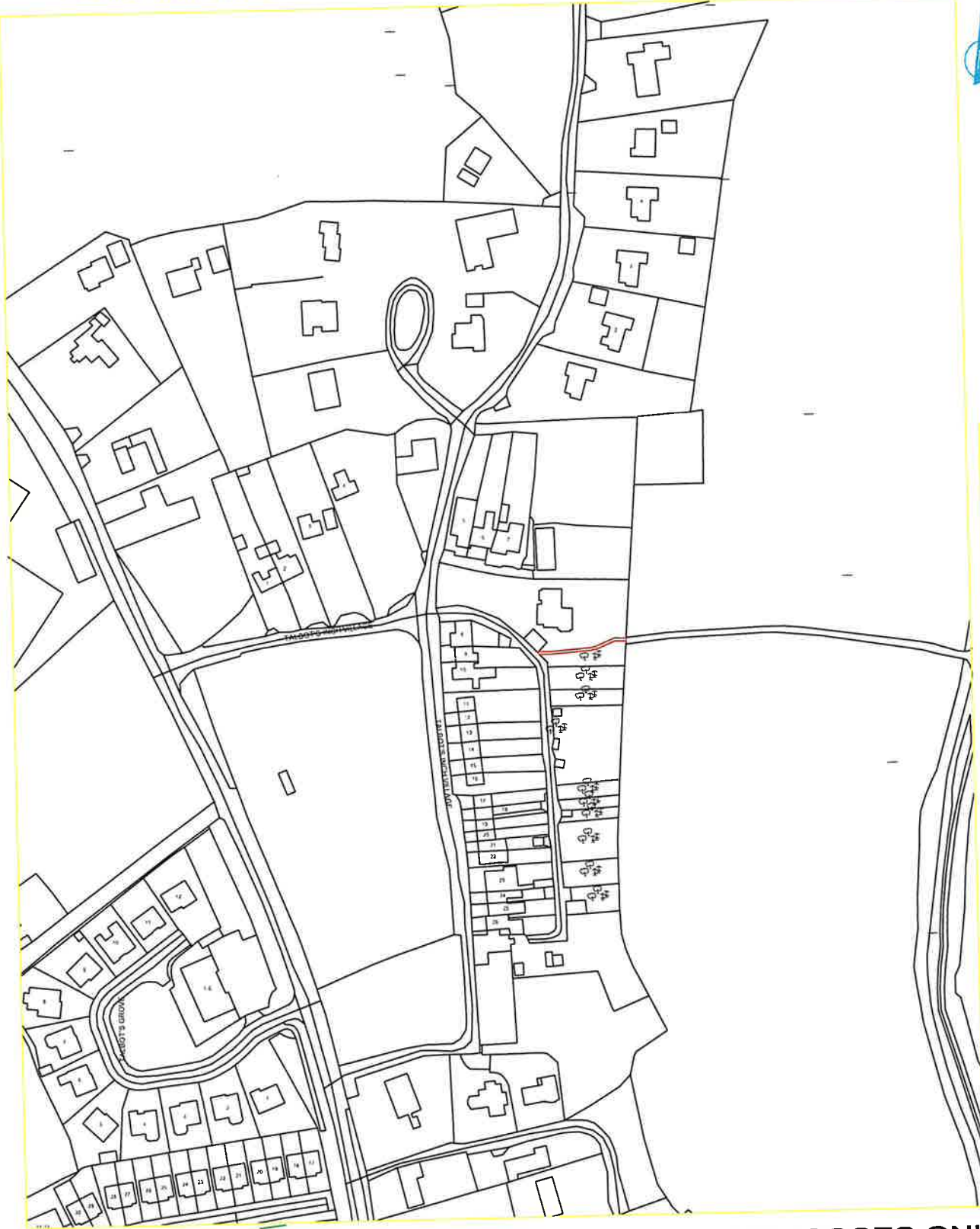
